
A Living Faith Head, Heart & Hands

- ~ Mentors & confirmands discuss your responses to the following questions. Only confirmands are asked to right down their responses. ~
- 1. Did you know that since the beginning of Christianity, hundreds of thousands of believers (and possibly even millions) have been persecuted and even died because of their faith? How does it make you feel to hear other Christians in the world even today are killed because of their love for Jesus?

2. People have suggested Jesus could have changed the world by using his power and authority rather than suffering and dying on the cross. What do you feel God was telling and showing us by suffering for us rather than using power?

4. In the Gospel of John, the word "faith" is always a verb, something we do not something we think. Why do you feel this is?
